

AFRICAN MISSION

African Mission is presently supporting the following projects:



Dr Ray Towey left his post as a Consultant Anaesthetist in Guys Hospital, London, to work in Africa and for the last 22 years has dedicated his life to the improvement of health care for the poor in Africa. African Mission raises the funds needed to buy ICU equipment for St Mary's Hospital, Gulu, Uganda (where Dr Towey works) and helps with the costs of course & exam fees for some of the nurses.



Fatima Mission is a very large mission in rural Zimbabwe. The majority of those living within its boundaries are poor subsistence farmers reliant on Maize, Chomolia (a green vegetable) and a few cows, goats or chickens as their only source of food. The mission is a Roman Catholic mission run by two Franciscan orders, the Capuchin Fathers & the FMDM Sisters. It has 16 primary and 5 secondary schools, a bush boarding school, a project for disabled children and a project for blind adults within its boundaries.



African Mission has built new classrooms and teachers accommodation for three primary schools (Dungu, St John's & St Francis' primary schools). We have also help provide tables, chairs & books. In 2017 we are raising funds to build a second classroom for St Francis' primary school. This will cost £19,890.

Education project for disabled children (within Fatima Mission). This is a residential project offering education to 19 disabled children, 9 are unable to speak, 3 are totally blind and 7 are partially sighted. This project offers hope to a group who otherwise would be faced with an extremely difficult future. It costs £528 to cover the costs of one child's school fees and living costs for an academic year. We are also raising funds to build an activities centre where the children can play, read, learn a musical instrument or use a computer. This will cost £54,564.

We have begun to improve the life chances of some of the children living in this remote part of Zimbabwe and also the patients at St Mary's Hospital, Uganda. In order for us to continue to do so, we need you help.
